 - 3) Forming a Proverbs 27:17 environment (As iron sharpens iron, so a friend sharpens a friend.)
- Build community among students by:
 - 1) Providing 2 evening ministry experiences on campus and at least one week long experience off WRCC campus to disciple the students (this is outside the weekly worship services).
 - 2) Serving together providing experiences where students serve others together throughout the year
 - 3) Playing together providing fun filled experiences that will allow students to build relationships with one another
