Who should apply:

This is a mission trip for anyone 16 years and older (those under 16 need to be accompanied by an adult). Those with a heart for ministering to local church planters and students at an area Teachers College are especially encouraged to apply. All applicants will be interviewed before acceptance on the trip.

Trip dates: Thursday, October 12, 2017 – Sunday, October 22, 2017

- Transportation: International flights from Indianapolis to Tanzania, ground transportation to CMF compound in Arusha
- Passport required

Trip cost: \$3,400

- Trip cost includes air fare, ground transportation, lodging, meals, and ministry materials
- \$250 non-refundable deposit due with application, 50% of trip cost due by 08/15, 100% due by 09/28
